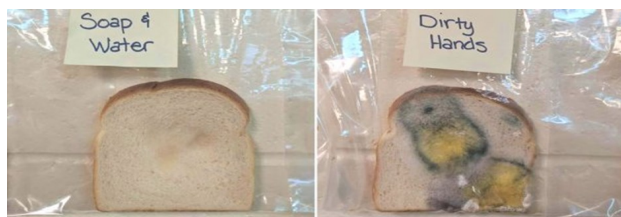




GOODBYE GERMS

Keeping hands clean is one of the most important steps we can take to avoid getting sick and spreading germs to others.

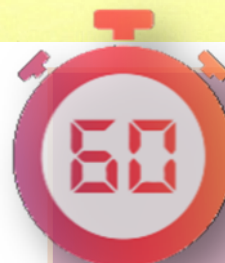
Let's Wash Our Hands!

THE VALUE OF FRIENDSHIP

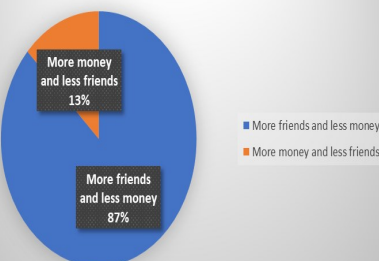
For this months survey we asked you if you would rather have more money and less friends or less money and more friends.

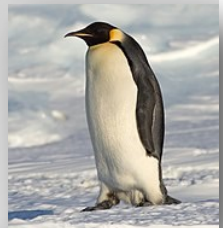
Electricity makes our lives easier but it is also very dangerous. We need to make sure that we stay safe near electricity. See our handy tips below.
